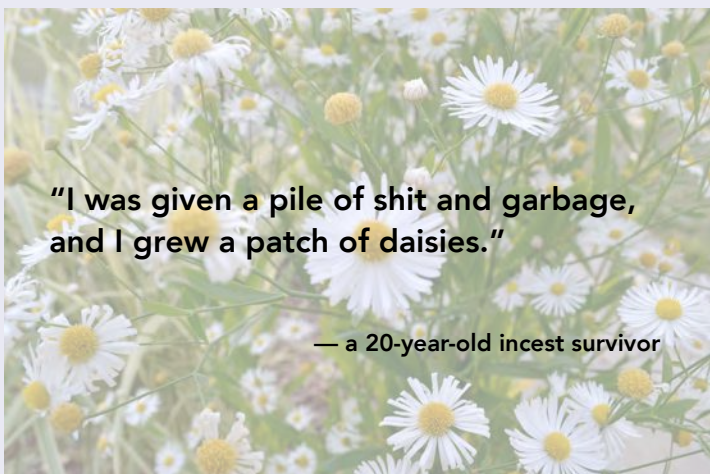

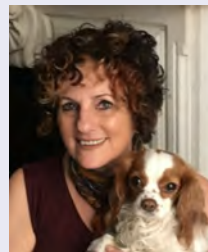

incest and all sex abuse knows no color, class or nationality. Over 90% of sex abuse happens within families and with trusted friends or relatives.

These girls are our nieces, neighbors, girls on the soccer team, the debate club, girls working in the boutique down the street. These are young women bound for college or full time jobs. These are girls living in marginal neighborhoods, girls living in upper middle class neighborhoods. These are our girls from rural communities to urban communities. These are invisible girls until they reach out and tell their truths.

Without the support of her mother, or other relatives she often has no-one to go to for help. She has kept her secret and by the time a girl discloses her sexual abuse she may already feel alone. She often believes the abuse is somehow her fault. These wonderful girls have not been safe, physically or emotionally.

EMPOWERS

Girlthrive honors girls who have survived incest by awarding them with thiverships ranging from \$300-500 to pursue creative endeavors. Girls have received thiverships to pursue dance, drama, yoga, glass blowing, horseback riding, massage therapy to name a few. Girls receive thiverships to help pay for college tuition, moving costs, academic books, workshops, nursing school, medical school, application fees. Each year Girlthrive awards an average of 10-12 thiverships!

ADVOCATES

Girlthrive gets the book *Invisible Girls* into the hands of the girls and professionals that need it by donating copies to foster care agencies, prisons, hospitals, courts, rape crisis centers, group homes and individual girls who reach out to Dr. Patti.
